COMPETITION CONDITIONS

- Entrance fees must be paid at the time of entry otherwise entries may be rejected. Refunds will not be made for cancellation after the closing date. Early entries would be appreciated.
- The Committee of Management of the Long Island Country Club shall have the entire management of the Tournament including the power to alter a player's Australian Handicap in accordance with the Australian and W.G.A. Handicapping Systems. A.G.U. Handicap limit is 35.
- The Committee shall have the power to limit the number of entries, which will be accepted for any event and to alter the time fixed for starting any event as indicated in this programme.
- Players must be prepared to play when called on to do so by the Committee and must report to the Pro Shop at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled starting times.
- Entries are restricted to amateurs who are Members of the Victorian Golf Association or of Golf Clubs registered with such State or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognised by the Association or of Clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League, and the Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- All competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the links over which the competitions take place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competitions whose decision shall be final. Provided however the Committee if in doubt shall have the right to refer any such dispute to the council of the V.G.A., whose decision shall be final. Any such dispute must be made in writing to the Committee not later than fifteen minutes after completion of the day's play.
- No player is eligible to win more than one major trophy on the day.
- In the event of a tie the winner shall be determined on a count back under the system recommended by the V.G.A. and W.G.V.
- All entrants must notify the Official Starter before the commencement of any event of any alteration in handicap.
- The Match Committee of LICC may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten any competition or reschedule the event to another day.
- All competitors will be made Honorary Members of Long Island Country Club for the duration of the Tournament.
- Proof of current handicap may be required.
- Dress Code: Neat attire, in keeping with the dignity of a private Golf Club, no sand shoes and no denim clothing will be allowed to be worn by competitors or caddies on the course or in the Clubhouse.
