12 and 13 Holes Out of Play

Holes 12 and 13 are out of play and must be walked. Until greens 12 and 13 are back in play all competitions will be played over 16 holes. Under Rule 7-2 no strokes can be made on holes 12 or 13 as it will be deemed practicing between holes. The penalty for breaching the rule is a penalty of two strokes or loss of hole in matchplay. In keeping with recent changes made to the Australian (USGA) handicapping system, all scores on holes 12 and 13 during competition rounds are to be recorded as a net par. For example a member who receives a stroke on the par 4 12th hole will record a 5.

Access to 10th Hole

To access the 10th hole members are requested to take their buggies around the left hand bunker via the rear of the 9th hole and to take the asphalt pathway passed the Club office towards the 10th hole.

Clubhouse Redevelopment Works Itinerary

Continuing on from last weeks works schedule the coming weeks work ending Friday 30 September will be concentrating on the following areas;

Basement: All the columns for the ground floor will be poured together with 75% of the basement slab. Preparation for the installation of the precast walls will also commence.

Clubhouse: The clubhouse ground floor section will commence as demolition will be complete. Piling for the clubhouse structure will commence and will be 50% complete by weeks end. There are a total of 93 piles to be constructed. The plumbing services will also commence to the service area facilities.

External Works: The eastern car park area will be prepared with base course work and the stormwater drainage installation will be continued and completed in the car parking areas.
